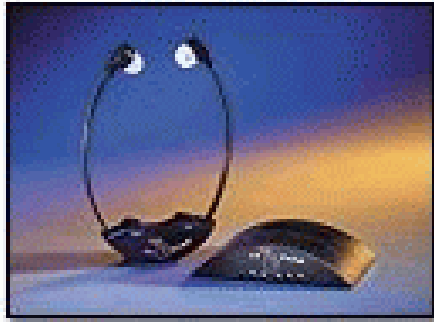


TV Ears

At some point, most people have had trouble hearing in certain situations. This problem is not isolated within the hard of hearing population; even people with normal hearing can experience trouble understanding in the presence of background noise.

Infrared, FM, and induction loop systems enable people with hearing loss to hear clearer TV sound and, to their family members' relief, with their own individually adjusted volume.

If desired, it is also possible to hear room sounds, including conversation, or the phone ringing, by using the MT setting on the hearing aid. You can find out if your hearing aid has an MT setting by asking your audiologist.

If your hearing aid does not have this feature, then a microphone can be patched into the loop amplifier. (Some loop systems include a microphone that broadcasts room sounds along with TV sound.)
